Before Travelling to Austria

Insurance

- **EU/EEA citizens** holding a [European Health Insurance Card \(EHIC\)](#) are (with a few exceptions) also insured in Austria. Before arriving in Austria, please obtain detailed information from your insurance provider. We also recommend purchasing private health insurance that additionally includes a clause to cover any required transportation back to your home country.
- **Third-country nationals** are required to have health and travel insurance that is also valid in Austria and covers any and all risks.

Wi-Fi and IT

The Wi-Fi network Eduroam is available throughout the Johannes Kepler University Linz (JKU) campus. Eduroam is a secure, worldwide roaming access service developed to support the international research and education community. See the official Eduroam website:

Arriving in Linz and Getting Around

Arrival

You can fly into Linz, however the Linz airport is fairly small and has fewer direct international connections. International flights commonly connect to Linz from Vienna (VIE) or Frankfurt (FRA). These are smaller flights operated by Austrian Airlines or Lufthansa. There are other travel options with an additional train connection to Linz from nearby airports (e.g. Vienna VIE, Salzburg SZG; Munich MUC). Bus transfer to the central railway station in Linz (~ 20 min)

There is a direct bus connection between the Linz airport and the central railway station in Linz (Bus No. 601). The travel time is approx. 20 minutes. This service is not available 24/7 (and can be particularly difficult with late-arriving flights), we recommend taking a taxi to Linz.

Taxi transfer

Taxis are located directly in front of the arrivals terminal. Taxi fare to the city center is approximately an average of € 35.00, and approximately € 50.00 to the University. When traveling back, you can contact one of the taxi companies located in Linz e.g. Taxi 6969 P +43 732 6969 (24 hours), <https://www.taxi6969.at/> or Taxi 2244 P +43 732 2244 (24 hours), <https://www.taxi2244.at/> to take you back to the airport or train station.

Tram transfer

When arriving at the central railway station, “Hauptbahnhof Linz”, the easiest way to get downtown or to the JKU campus is to take the tram (running every few minutes). Take the escalator/stairs to the underground tram station. Take tram number **1** or **2** in the direction “Universität” and exit at the last stop “Universität”. The travel time is approximately 25 min. To get to the hotels in the old section of Linz, get off at the main square at the stop at “Hauptplatz”. Once at this stop, to get to the JKU campus you can take either tram 1 or 2 in the direction “Universität”. Tickets are valid for both the trams and buses. During the Conference

Registration

All registered delegates are asked to come to the registration and information desk in Lecture Hall 1 (HS1) in the Kepler Building at the JKU, open on August 9 between 2:00 PM and 5:00 PM, on August 10 between 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM, on August 11 between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM, and on August 12 between 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM. Delegates will receive a name badge and a welcome envelope containing all of the required information. Check the campus map in the conference booklet to locate the Kepler Hall.

During the conference, please wear your name badge at all times as it will facilitate easier access to sessions, tea and coffee breaks, lunch breaks, and daytrips. Local Information

The Johannes Kepler University Linz (JKU) is located in walking distance from the final tram stop University ("Universität", tram lines 1 and 2). During the conference, you will be able to get to all of the buildings and rooms on foot.

Parking

There are two parking lots on the JKU campus as well as an underground car park located below the Science Park. There are approximately 1,465 parking spaces available, of which about 400 are designated for those parking for a short-term. Access the main campus parking lot from the Altenberger Street (Straße in German), or from Mengerstraße. The daily visitor rate is € 1.30 for 30 minutes. 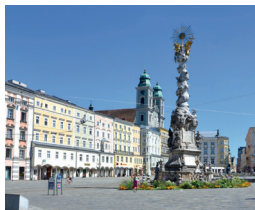
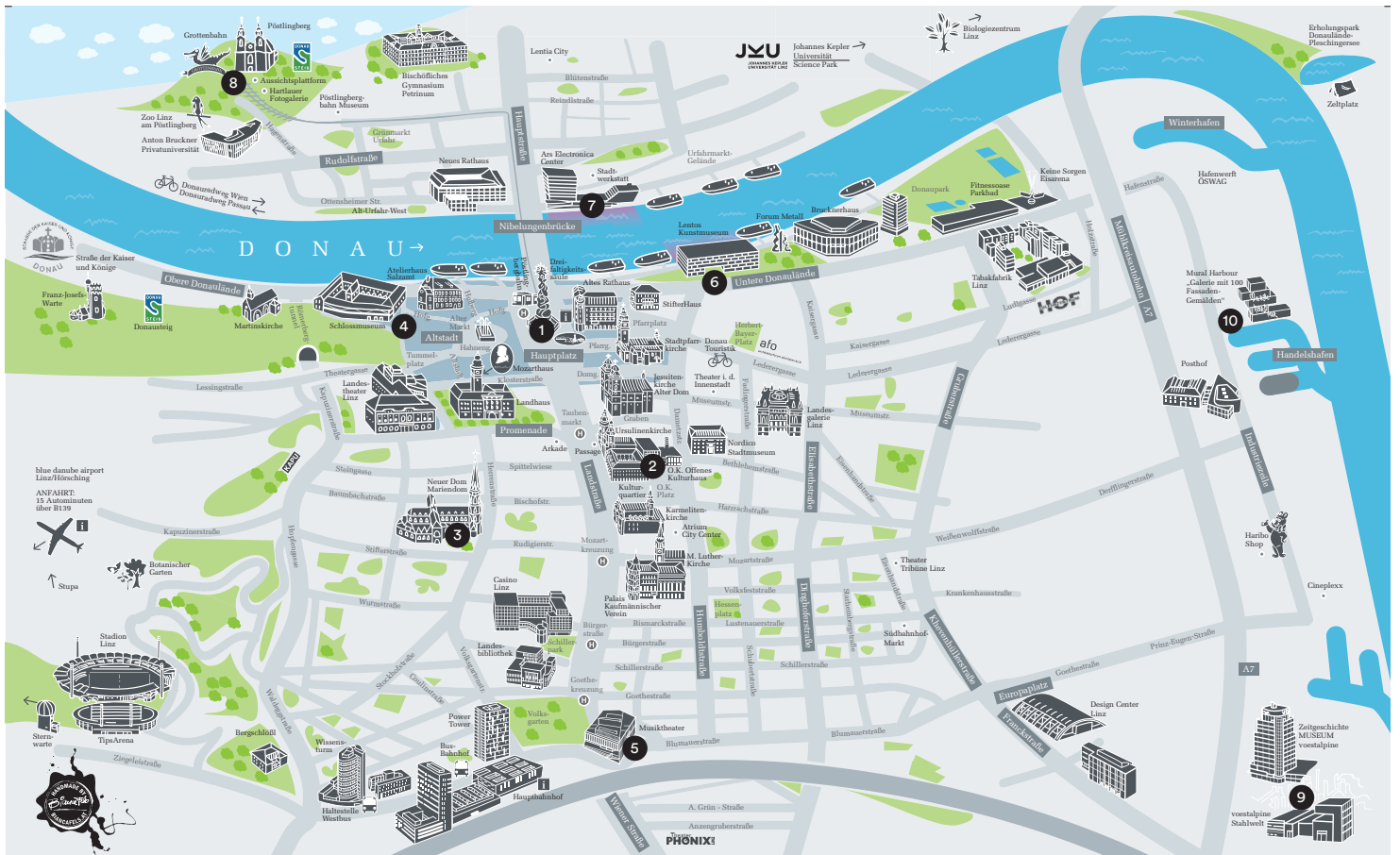

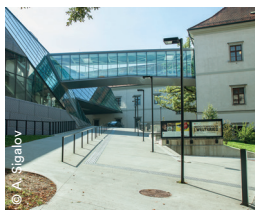
1 Hauptplatz
The main square (Hauptplatz) with its impressive Trinity Column is an awe-inspiring location. Sited a stone's throw from the River Danube, baroque buildings in bright pastel colours enclose one of the largest public squares in Europe. Its numerous cafés and restaurants are the ideal places to take break.



2 OÖ Kulturquartier
Upper Austria's culture quarter (OÖ Kulturquartier) is the creative hotspot of Linz. In addition to restaurants, a cinema and various festivals, regular exhibitions about contemporary art are held in the OK Centre (Offenes Kulturhaus). In summer, the "Höhenrausch" exhibit shows media art over the roofs of the city.



3 Mariendom
In terms of seating capacity, the New Cathedral (Mariendom) is the largest church in Austria. With its open, contemporary interior, this neo-Gothic cathedral is a quiet oasis in the heart of the city. Its colourful stained-glass windows and the view from the tower are also spectacular.



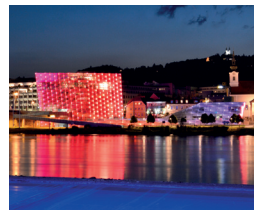
4 Altstadt & Schlossmuseum
The castle is home to a museum (Schlossmuseum) showcasing Upper Austria's natural, cultural and artistic heritage. The mighty construction boasts impressive architecture and captivating views over the baroque old town. As in the rest of the city centre, its many shops make this area great for browsing.



5 Musiktheater am Volksgarten
Musicals, operas and dance theatre have all found their home at the "Musiktheater". Opened in 2013, this impressive building on the edge of the city's Volksgarten park is one of the most state-of-the-art opera houses in Europe. Its productions have delighted audiences and critics alike.



6 Lentos Kunstmuseum
The modern edifice of the Lentos Art Museum (Lentos Kunstmuseum) sits on the bank of the River Danube like a super-sized picture frame. The museum houses one of the most important collections of modern and contemporary art, with works by Klimt, Kokoschka and Schiele. At night, its illuminated facade makes quite an impression.



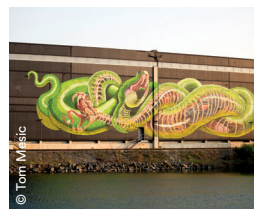
7 Ars Electronica Centre
This "Museum of the Future" is dedicated to the world of tomorrow. Interactive exhibits artistically highlight the impact of technology on our daily lives. Multimedia presentations, including 3D animations, in Deep Space 8K also offer a unique experience.



8 Pöstlingberg
At 539 metres high, the Pöstlingberg hill with its pilgrimage basilica towers over the city. This "local mountain" is climbed in 20 minutes by the Pöstlingbergbahn, one of the steepest railways in the world. The panoramic terrace, the zoo and the "Grottenbahn" fantasy ride through the kingdom of the dwarves are all worth a visit.



9 voestalpine Stahlwelt
The unique world of discovery at the voestalpine World of Steel revolves around steel. The multimedia and interactive exhibition gives visitors an insight into the production process all the way through to the finished product. Guided tours of the factory site are also fascinating.



10 Mural Harbor
Linz harbour is adorned with more than 100 works of graffiti art stretching up the sides of industrial buildings to heights of 50 metres. "Mural Harbor" is one of the largest coherent outdoor graffiti galleries in the world. After taking a tour, visitors can try their hand as graffiti artists.
